Storm Water Management and Sediment Control

(20,000 sq. ft. or more of land disturbance)

As required by the Knox County Subdivision Regulations Article III section 3.01:C., anyone proposing a land disturbance of 20,000 square feet or more, must submit a plan to the Knox County Storm Water Administrator outlining the proposed means of controlling erosion and managing storm water during and after execution of the project.

My signature indicates that I have read the sections of the Knox County Subdivision Regulations that pertain to land disturbances on individual lots. I understand that I am responsible for controlling erosion and managing storm water on the following lot and that all contractors and sub-contractors are included in this responsibility. I agree to allow periodic inspections by Soil and Water Conservation District personnel to assure compliance with the regulation and understand that noncompliance could result in fines being assessed or stop work orders being issued. I/we intend to comply with these regulations.
