NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Knox County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 4, 2024, at 11:00 a.m., in order to discuss the proposed PY 2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Allocation and Critical Infrastructure grant applications. The hearing will be held in the large board room at the Commissioners' Office, 117 East High Street, Suite 161, Mount Vernon, OH 43050.

Knox County is eligible for \$158,000 in Program Year 2024 CDBG Allocation funds provided the County meets applicable program requirements. Out of the \$158,000, \$127,000 is proposed to be used for the installation of parks and recreation accessibility and equipment in the Village of Danville, \$3,000 for Fair Housing, and \$28,000 for Administration. The project will meet the national objective of benefitting low-to-moderate-income persons.

Knox County also intends to apply for a \$500,000 competitive Critical Infrastructure Grant to replace the waterlines on Market Street in Danville. Of this, \$470,000 will go to the project and \$30,000 for Administration. The project will meet the national objective of benefitting low-to-moderate-income persons.

Awards for both of the proposed grants will be announced in August 2024 and all work must be completed by August 2026.

Citizens are encouraged to attend the public hearing to provide input and comment on the proposed applications before they are submitted to the Ohio Department of Development on June 4, 2024.
