2025 Wildlife Packet Order Form

The Knox Soil and Water Conservation District conducts a Wildlife Packet program each year that is designed to meet a specific need by landowners to acquire small numbers of trees and shrub stock. This stock is suitable for use in backyards, odd corners, steep banks, or for the development of wildlife land. Transplanting is not necessary and with reasonable care a fine planting can be developed.

All stock is state and federally inspected. It may be necessary for us to make reasonable substitutions based on availability of certain species; however, we guarantee that only first quality plants will be used.

The deadline for ordering your packets is April 1, 2025 or until our supply is exhausted. There is no limit to the number of packets ordered, however, payment must be included with your order and orders will be processed on a first come basis. In April, you will receive notification when the packets will be delivered.

Planting instructions, as well as a guide to plant, will accompany your packet at the time of delivery. Payment can be made through a money order, personal check, or cash and must accompany the order. Please remember that these plants are seedlings and the packet will be about the size of a small bag of groceries. Delivery time should be around the third week of April. If you do not receive notification during the second week of April, please contact the Knox SWCD at (740) 393-6724.

Eastern White Pine Packet (10 seedlings 6"-12") \$16/pkt



These seedlings are large conifers with needles 5 to a cluster and 2 to 5 inches long. This is an excellent shade and ornamental tree. Our best pine for lumber and rapid growth.

Norway Spruce Packet (10 seedlings 12"-18") \$12/pkt



A medium to rapid growing evergreen of conical form. Cones are pendant shaped and needles usually have four sides, stiff and sharp to the touch. Good drainage is necessary.

Red Oak Packet (5 seedlings 18"- 24") \$13/pkt



This wide, massive, long-lived shade tree is fast growing, reaching 80 to 90 feet at maturity. It's lustrous green leaves change to russet red in fall. It is commercially valuable as timber and provides acorns for wildlife.

Kousa Dogwood Packet (3 seedlings 18"- 24") \$11/pkt



A flowering tree that produces white flowers in spring. Leaves are dark green in summer changing to reddish purple or scarlet in fall. Grows 20 to 30 feet. Plant in moist well drained soil, in full sun to partial shade.

White Oak Packet (5 seedlings 1'-2') \$14/pkt



A large (90 feet) majestic native tree with wide spreading branches and leaves of blue-green which turn wine colored in the fall. Tolerates most soils except those very wet. It has a slow to medium growth rate. An extremely valuable timber tree and provides acorns for wildlife.

Chinese Chestnut Tree Packet (5 seedlings) 1'-2' \$15/pkt

A prolific bearer of delicious nuts, similar to the American Chestnut, but is blight resistant. Smaller

than the American Chestnut. With plenty of room to grow, it will resemble the shape of an apple tree.

PawPaw Packet (3 seedlings 6"-12" \$12/pkt



Grows to 25 feet tall, has large clusters of leaves, distinctive fruits and dark purple blossoms. Leaves are very large, bright green in color and can be as large as 12 inches long and five inches wide. PawPaw trees produce the largest edible fruits native to the United States. Trees prefer moist and slightly acidic soil. Trees can be planted in full and partial sunlight conditions and may even tolerate full shade in some areas. PawPaw trees are low maintenance. Young plants require regular watering with best chance of thriving in deep and well drained soil.

Persimmon Packet (3 seedlings 6 -12") \$12/pkt



Growth habit: Slender, oval-rounded form; usually has a symmetrical outline. Tree size: 35 to 60 feet tall, 20 to 35 Set wide. Flowers are white to greenish white and are shaped like blueberry flowers. Blooms in late April. Fruit is a yellowish to pale orange berry that is 1" to 1 1/2" across. Fruit is edible, ripens in September or October. It is delicious when ripe, but highly unpleasant before ripening. Leaf is alternate, simple leaves are 2" to 5" long and are 3/4" to 2" wide. Dark green in summer but little to no fall color.

Ornamental Packet (6 seedlings/3 varieties 1'-2' \$19/pkt



Allegheny Serviceberry: is a small, native, understory tree with four-season interest. The early white spring flowers, outstanding orange-red fall color, and striking gray bark make it a lovely specimen for any landscape. The edible purplish-black fruit in late summer is attractive to many birds. Grows 15 to 25 feet in partial sun/shade (4-6 hrs. light daily), moist, well drained soil. Growth rate moderate.

American Plum: Grows 15 to 30 feet tall with a wide spreading crown. Thrives in various soil types but prefers welldrained dry to medium soils. Does best in full sun or partial shade and can tolerate rocky and sandy soils. Early to mid -spring brings clusters of white flowers that develop into edible red plums, ripening in early summer.





Redbud: Grows to 25 to 35 feet. Thrives in full sun to light shade. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. In early spring, before the leaves appear, the branches and twigs are adorned with numerous showy pinkish-purple flowers.
